Finish Along Overview + Materials List

Gusseted Standup

Learn to finish your own gusseted standup in this 2 hour class. This is a great next step if you've finished a few ornaments including rectangular and squares. You will need to bring a completed front, back, and two lengths of cording to this class.

Selecting your project for class

For beginners, your project should be square, rectangular, or have an arched top with a flat bottom edge of at least 3" in width, so it sits nicely on a surface. If you have experience with special shapes, these are also welcome.

Materials

- ☐ Completed front and back (following the instructions for completing a round ornament or square/rectangle ornament. Just stop before you assemble)
- ☐ Two lengths of completed cording (long enough to wrap around your project)
- ☐ Invisible thread
- ☐ Size 7 needle
- ☐ Tapestry needle
- ☐ Fabric for the gusset (non-stretchy materials work best, 2 inches wider than your gusset thickness and 2 inches longer than the circumference of your project)
- ☐ Piece of cardstock (from the scrapbooking section of your craft store, longer than the circumference of your project)
- ☐ Dressmaker pins or tape (to attach the card stock to the foam)
- ☐ Foam (cut to the size of your canvas; I recommend layering sheets of acid-free foam core to your desired thickness. You can cut foam core with an Xacto knife)
- ☐ Masking tape or framer's tape
- ☐ Weight such as a stainless steel nut that will fit in your project.

How to Join

- ☐ Add the date and time to your calendar. We provide digital calendar links on the sign up page for ease.
- ☐ Make sure your membership is active. On the day of the Finish Along, all currently active members of The Needlepoint Finishing Club will receive the Zoom link
